Situation

Due to the threat of further escalation of the situation in Ukraine and the real risk of a large-scale emergency with a significant impact on the civilian population, the State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SES) has requested support from the international community.

Request for assistance

On 15 February 2022, the State Emergency Service of Ukraine activated the EU Civil Protection mechanism (UCPM) requesting in-kind assistance under the following categories:

- **Medical supplies** (e.g. PPE, medicines, first aid materials, disinfectant)
- **Shelter supplies** (logistics centre, field camps, drinking water tanks)
- **Communication equipment** (car radios, portable radios, stationary transceivers)
- **Various tools** (metal detector, thermal imagers, diesel electricity generators, fire hoses, motor pumps)
- **Motor vehicles** (e.g. trucks with cranes, tractors, off-road 4x4 vehicles, laboratory vehicles, decontaminations vehicles, inflatable engine boats)

Response

The Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC) stands ready to coordinate offers from EU Member States and UCPM Participating States.

On 17 February, **Slovenia** offered 1 million non-medical disposable masks, which were accepted by Ukraine. Delivery is expected during the week of 21 February. Slovenia also offered 10 diesel generators, 125 000 pairs of nitrile gloves and 125 000 pairs of latex gloves and 200 rubber boots, acceptance is pending.

On 17 February, **Romania** offered 5 000 packs of analgesics, 5 000 packs of anti-inflammatory medicines, 5 000 packs for antibiotics and 840 litres of disinfectant for hand treatment. **Ireland** offered 20 000 protective suits, 150 000 medical and surgical masks, hand sanitiser and 50 000 litres of disinfectant for

hand treatment. Both offers were accepted by Ukraine.

On 18 February, **France** offered 15 tents for 15 persons, 300 family tents for 5 persons, 1 500 ground sheets, 2 100 blankets and 300 sleeping bags, 500 hygiene kits, 25 dry latrines, 3 000 CBRN gloves. On 19 February, France made an additional offer of 200 family tents for 5 persons (total: 500), 500 blankets (total: 2 600), 750 ground sheets for sleeping (total: 2 250), 500 hygiene kits (total: 1 000). The offers were accepted and delivery is expected on 28 February.

On 18 February, **Austria** offered 50 000 litres of hand disinfectant, 9 000 litres of surface disinfectant, 50 000 facemasks, 20 000 non-sterile gloves, 50 000 safety goggles. The offer is pending acceptance.
