

AGREEMENT

REGARDING THE FISCAL ENTITLEMENTS GRANTED
ACCORDING TO PARAGRAPHS 1 AND 6 OF THE ARTICLE 17 OF
THE AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE PARIS PROTOCOL
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA AND THE SUPREME
HEADQUARTERS ALLIED POWERS EUROPE AND
HEADQUARTERS, SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER
TRANSFORMATION

The Republic of Lithuania on the one side and the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe and Headquarters, Supreme Allied Commander Transformation, on the other,

Pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 6 of the Article 17 of the Agreement supplementing the Paris protocol between the Republic of Lithuania and the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe and Headquarters, Supreme Allied Commander Transformation, which was signed on the 19th of March 2015,

Desiring to set further detailed arrangements regarding the amount of motor fuel and lubricants that members of the Allied Headquarters and their dependants are entitled to purchase free of taxes, duties, fees and charges,

Noting that all entitlements are afforded to members of the Allied Headquarters and their dependents in support of their mission,

Have reached the following agreement:

Article 1

For the purpose of this agreement terms “Allied Headquarters”, “Members“, “Dependant”, “Support unit of the Republic of Lithuania” shall have the meanings as defined in the

Agreement supplementing the Paris protocol between the Republic of Lithuania and the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe and Headquarters, Supreme Allied Commander Transformation.

Article 2

1. Each Member of the Allied Headquarters, including Dependents of that Member, upon request by the tax administrator, have to provide documents proving that the vehicles belong to that Member and that the Member is entitled to purchase tax-free fuel with a monthly limit of:
Motor fuel: 200 litres per month for all privately owned vehicles in general;
Lubricants: 2 litres per month for all privately owned vehicle in general.
2. The above stated entitlements of tax-free motor fuel and lubricants do not extend to the national support unit(s) of the Republic of Lithuania.

Article 3

1. This Agreement will enter into force when signed on behalf of all Parties, as of the date of the last signature.
2. This Agreement may be amended at any time by written agreement of the Parties. It may be terminated by either Party giving written notice to the other of the intention to terminate it, in which case it shall terminate two years after the date of receipt of such notice.
3. Any dispute arising from the interpretation or implementation of this Agreement will be resolved through direct consultation between the Parties.
4. Regardless of the above, this Agreement shall terminate on the effective date of termination of the Agreement supplementing the Paris protocol between the Republic of Lithuania and the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe and Headquarters, Supreme Allied Commander Transformation.

Signed in duplicate in the Lithuanian and English languages, all texts being equally authentic. In case of any divergence of interpretation, the English text will prevail.
