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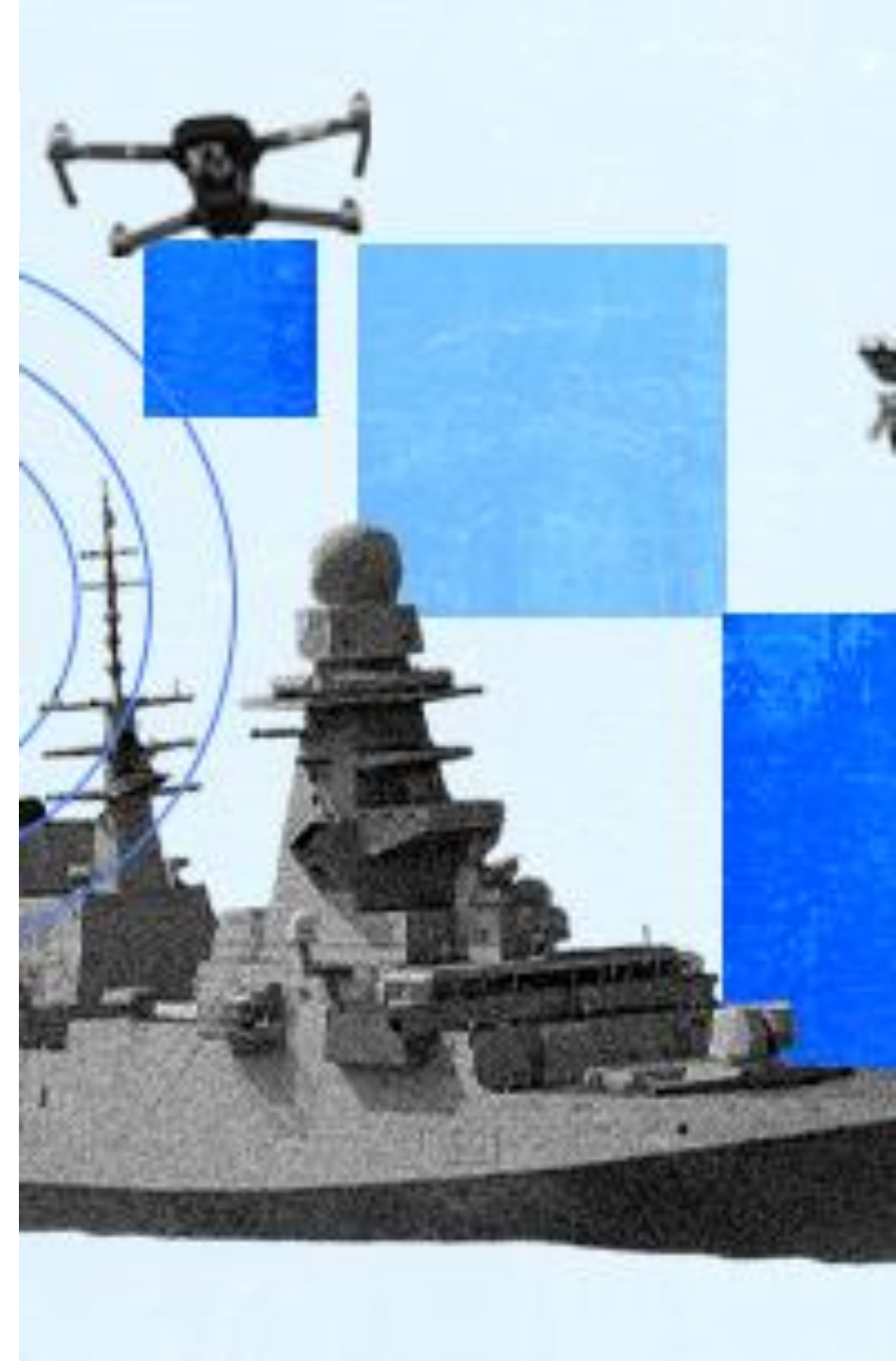
Structural Support to Defence Procurement

Context

- **< 20% of defence spending through collaborative channels** (EU target= 40% in 2030)
- inconsistent transposition of EU law,
- absence of harmonised joint procurement frameworks,
- administrative capacity gaps,
- lack of guidance on collaborative procurement

Objectives

- **aligning national legal and procedural frameworks** with EU rules and good practices
- **strengthening the administrative capacity** of national contracting authorities
- **developing common procedures and tools** to enhance cross-country collaboration
