- Procurement data is **fragmented across Member States**
- PPDS was **launched in 2024** with 10 further countries (currently or soon to be) connected

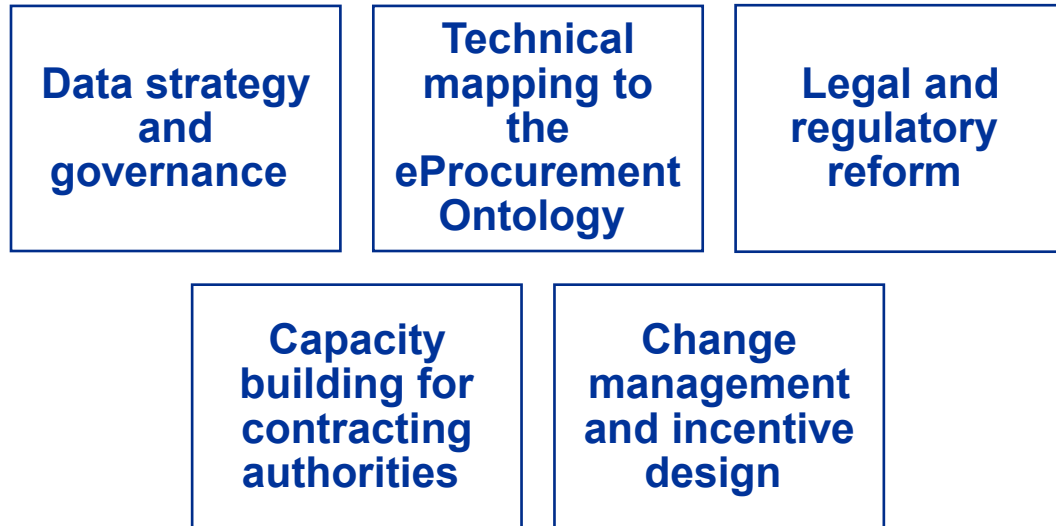
Objectives
